



TEAM SELECTION PROCEDURE

Given the continual growth of the club, it was decided in October 2014 (during the AGM) that we conduct try-outs to organise and select teams. The reasons for this were:

- To remain competitive by placing players in the levels/grades that suits their abilities.
- The aim is to create the best side first and then according to skill levels, team
 play and numbers, consequent teams will be in order (ie A,B,C,D etc).
 Subsequent teams then become feeders for the next level.
- To have a fair and professional procedure in which a selected committee decides the teams (not the players, parents or coaches) based on skills sets and team play.

TRY-OUTS:

- Try-outs will be conducted where there are multiple teams to be made.
- A selection committee will make notes during the session and gain feedback from existing coaches where required. At the end of try-outs, the committee meets and discuss at length each player and allocate them into the appropriate team.
- Selections are made based on skill, team play and numbers.
- This is then presented and passed by the committee.
- We then have time during the first 3 grading games to trial players at different levels within the age group. This is a vital ingredient to assess the player(s) in a game environment/application. This means that players may be playing in different teams during the grading games until the committee finds the right team for him/her.
- No team selections are final until after the 3rd grading game.
- Players who have joined the club during the grading games and have missed out on try-outs will be assessed during this time.
- If changes are to be made, the committee, in consultation with the coach will discuss and decide.
- Players who join the club after the grading games, will automatically be placed in the lower level.

If there are any queries or issues regarding the above, it must be put in writing to the selection committee before it can be considered.
